In 2007, the Chamber is advocating for the abolishing of container fees which adds on to the high cost of doing business in GHANA

In 2007, the Chamber is assisting members to bid for UN contracts to provide services in Sierra Leone, Liberia etc.

In 2006 the Chamber received 512 business enquiries from companies around the world looking for potential partners in Ghana for Joint Venture, Export Orders, Agency etc. this information is available to our members.

In 2006 the Chamber assisted members to participate in Trade Fairs in the oil rich countries of Equatorial Guinea and Angola by providing free stand space and subsidized freight rates.

In 2006 the Chamber advocated for a reduction in withholding which was captured in the 2007 National Budget as follows

Dividends= 8% (10% previously)

Management and Technical Services = 15% (20% previously)

Rent Income = 8% (10% previously)

Capital Gains= 5% (10% previously)

In 2006 the Chamber hosted 10 Trade Missions from China, India, Belgium, Spain, Netherlands, Nigeria, Romania, Iran and South Africa, where members made contacts with potential partners at the B2B meetings
